Life after diagnosis is a changed life. Things that most people take for granted, you no longer can. Every holiday is like Thank you God! I love my birthday, I love everybody's birthday. Some people say, I hate getting older. Not me. I love every minute of it.

Having cancer isn't the worst thing in the world. So many wonderful things have happened to me since I was diagnosed. I have made many new friends, and I see people reaching out to one another to support breast cancer research.

Each time Dr. Younger told me that my cancer metastasized, I just sat there looking at him thinking, How many tomorrows are left for me? How am I going to tell my family? How will my body be able to handle yet another blow? I kept waiting, my heart racing, for Dr. Younger to offer a plan for me, a course of treatment. I knew that I faced yet another battle, but we had a strategic plan in place. He gave me hope.

It has been a long road, but everyone has the potential to do something positive in his or her own fight. If everyone supported the efforts being made, then we would make greater and more expedient gains in finding the cure. Having cancer can be positive. I know.

Janet's words of hope and optimism inspire us to continue to raise funds and awareness for breast cancer research. Help us continue her fight.
